
Church of Saint Therese

Dear Friends,

I have just a few highlights for this week. Deacon Don Moore has accepted a new job in avionics which has been his passion. I am grateful for his years here as our maintenance manager. Our maintenance budget grew because he was so good at finding hidden problems, and his talents helped us solve them more frugally. Thank you, Don, for your generous service and can-do attitude. You will be missed in our daily mix.

Secondly, I would like to highlight a couple of our funds that you may be unaware of. The Families in Need Fund is one of the ways we assist the poor in need. Recently the Memorial Park Apartments, as you can see from Haines Avenue, were struck by a vehicle and damaged on all three floors. There was also a gas leak that necessitated evacuation of all residents. Bryan Achbach, Executive Director for the Pennington County Housing and Redevelopment Commission remarked that many of the residents had no family to assist them in this emergency. St. Therese has members residing there who do have family assistance. Our parish was able to give a significant donation to assist the relief effort. Our parish front office has become very wise in helping the needy who come to our door.

Another fund, which is lagging this year, is the Seminarian Fund. Adopt a Seminarian, assists the Diocese in the education of our men in formation. We pledge at St. John's \$1200 a year, and at St. Therese \$12,000 a year. This year we have two more men applying.

Star of the North Eucharistic Congress

The Diocese of Crookston and the Diocese of Duluth are jointly hosting the Star of the North Eucharistic Congress May 17-18 in Bernidji, Minn., featuring speakers such as Bishop Robert Barron, Father Mike Schmitz, and Sister Jude Andrew Link, OP, as well as the two hosting bishops. Bishop Andrew Cozzens and Bishop Daniel Felton. The northern route of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will begin the next day at nearby Itasca State Park after a Pentecost Mass there.
