-- Fr. Kerry's Korner --

Dear Friends,

Ascension, going up to, implies an apparent absence in the moment and in the place where the disciples gathered. The disciples of Jesus didn't act like a group that felt his absence. His Emmaus disciples, in fact, returned in joy to Jerusalem to be with, wait with, the apostles. Jesus had said, "While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for 'the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days, you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'" AA 1.3 They understood they were now a part of Jesus. He would always be or dwell where they were.

We too, have experienced the tragedy, turned victory of the Cross. We have identified with the fear leading to the disciples' abandonment of the Lord. We have gloried in the splendor of Easter resurrection which transforms our sadness into joy. Josef Ratzinger, cum Benedict XVI, said of the Cross, "it is the royal throne from which Christ exercises his kingship and draws the human race to himself and into his wide-open arms. Christ's royal throne is the cross; his exaltation takes the form of what seems to the outsider the extreme of disgrace and humiliation....". In this light the Ascension is the confirmation of Christ's victory and our participation with Christ in glory.

Imagine, we who are in Christ, are now a part of the divine life of Jesus who, in his humanity, has gone up to heaven. In the Gospel of John 3.13 it says, "No one has gone up to heaven except the one who has come down from heaven, the Son of Man." In his human nature we all ascend to the Father, sharing in divine life. This is our great hope, "May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened, that you may know what is the hope that belongs to his call, what are the riches of glory in his inheritance among the holy ones, and what is the surpassing greatness of his power for us who believe . . . Eph. 1.18a.

As a people of hope, let us also wait in expectation for the "promise of the Father," the renewal of the Holy Spirit, Pentecost.

St. Therese CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION & Parish Potluck SUNDAY, JUNE 2, 2024

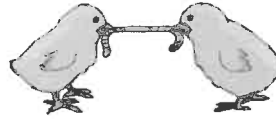
