

Dear Friends,

On June 2nd we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. Because of its importance in the life of the Eucharistic Revival, we will mark the day with a Eucharistic Procession and prayers along the way to our destination at Horace Mann Park. The procession makes our faith visible to the neighborhood and the city and is a spiritual sign of our walk with the Lord, strengthened by the nourishment of Christ's Body and Blood.

We will stop at an altar set up in front of Avantara North, which is along the route on North 7th St. If you can volunteer to help, we need people to bring our Catholic residents out to the social room or front porch, please contact me at the Office.

After we arrive, we will also celebrate with nourishment for our bodies! The parish will provide all the setups for our meal and drinks, the Knights of Columbus will cook and donate the entrée, while the rest of us can bring sides, salads, and desserts. If you have refrigerated items, or are participating in the procession, you may leave these at the church to be taken to the park for our parish picnic.

I hope we can have most of our 1st Communion Class process with us, our servers, and many parish groups. You are welcome to carry a banner or sign of the Eucharist in procession. I will offer my walk up for the return of our people who have not returned to the Church following Covid, and for my personal reparation for my sins.

Every one of us may walk for a different reason. But let us together give a sign of unity in the Eucharistic Lord and proclaim to our city the faith we are proud to proclaim. Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon, our diocese will take up a collection for the Catholic Communication Campaign (CCC). Please prayerfully consider supporting the collection this year. Half of collected funds stay right here in the Diocese of Rapid City, and the other half support communications projects in the United States and around the world. In 2023 we used our half of the funds (\$2887.64) to help fund communications from the Bishop's Office. We have made significant upgrades to the diocese's podcasting and RPR broadcasting, upgraded our Retreat Center Technology to livestream classes and diocesan events such as Pastoral Ministry Days to more remote parishes.

In 2018 the Campaign helped fund a documentary produced by Notre Dame University's New Media Group about the Cause for Canonization of Servant of God Nicholas Black Elk, which was initiated by Bishop Gruss and the Diocese of Rapid City. The film, *Walking the Good Red Road: Nicholas Black Elk's Journey to Sainthood* was completed in 2020. All rights were signed over to the Diocese of Rapid City. This film eloquently presents the story of this Lakota Catholic icon and his spirituality to inspire people to learn more about him.

On the national level, the Campaign supports Catholic News Service (CNS), a premier source of news about the pope and the Vatican for English-language Catholic media worldwide. CNS photography, videography, and written stories are provided free of charge to dioceses and are featured in nearly 100 Catholic newspapers and dioceses, including ours. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops features a daily highlight from CNS on their website.

When you support the Catholic Communication Campaign, you bring stories of the Catholic faith in action, like the story of Servant of God Nicholas Black Elk, to light for others and help the Church modernize how it communicates the Joy of the Gospel, through CNS coverage, social media, print communications and radio programming across America and around the world.


